

Grand Terrace Community Soccer Club Player Drop After Draft

Guidelines:

- Any player who withdraws after the draft is **NOT** entitled to a refund. However, the following process must be followed to officially drop a player from a team roster.
- A coach or parent must notify the Grand Terrace Community Soccer Club (GTCSC) Registrar if a player drops from a team after the draft.

Procedure:

- **Coach or Parent:** The coach or parent must notify the GTCSC registrar of a player drop from an assigned team. The coach or parent must obtain a "Player Drop After Draft" form, fill out the "Coach or Parent" section, sign, and forward to the GTCSC Registrar. The form can be obtained from the GTCSC website "www.GTSoccer.org".
- **GTCSC Registrar:** The registrar will call the parent and verify the reason for the player deciding to drop from GTCSC Soccer. The Registrar will pull the player Registration form and remove the player from the Team roster. The Registrar will file the form and player registration and forward a copy to the GTCSC Director of Coaches.
- **GTCSC Director of Coaches:** The Director of Coaches will follow up with parents to discuss reason player decided to drop, if necessary.
